It is a pleasure to inform you of the following action taken at the Pharmacy Technician Accreditation Commission meeting on May 9, 2019

VOTED

To approve for reaccreditation the pharmacy technician training program at Santa Ana College, Santa Ana, California; further,

To grant accreditation for six years (2025; a midterm progress report will be requested in three years.

(Note: The Commission requested that any updates and/or changes to the pharmacy technician training program should be addressed the in the midterm progress report.)

The Commission arrived at its decision based on a thorough review of the report of the survey conducted on October 16, 2018, and your facility's response to the survey findings.
